### CAMP MASSAD INFORMATION TO PARENTS

**HEALTH:** A Camp Health Officer will be on the campsite and there is a doctor's clinic and hospital nearby. There are no dental services. Therefore, campers should have dental care before coming to camp. \*\*Please do not schedule appointments for your child during camp. It is disruptive for a camper to leave during a session.

**MEDICINE**: <u>All</u> medication brought to camp <u>must</u> be turned in upon arrival at the bus. Every item must have the camper's name and instructions and all pills <u>must arrive at camp in</u> <u>blister packs</u>! Please note that should your child require medication while at camp due to illness, you will be billed for any expenses.



**EYE GLASSES**: If your child wears eye glasses, consider sending a second pair of glasses in case there is an issue or glasses are lost or broken. Should the camp have to repair your child's glasses while at camp you will be billed for any expenses.



**T-SHIRTS**: Your child will receive a Camp Massad tee shirt upon their arrival at camp in the size indicated in their registration.



SUBSTANCE USE: Smoking and the use of vaporisers, drugs, or alcohol are strictly prohibited. ANY CAMPER FOUND TO BE IN POSSESSION OF THESE ARTICLES WILL BE PROMPTLY SENT HOME.

### **ELECTRONICS:** Absolutely NO Cell Phones, smart Phones, wireless devices, TVs, laptops.

These items are not permitted at camp. Any forbidden devices will be confiscated and returned at the end of the session. The camp reserves the right to confiscate any device that interferes with/or affects campers' participation in programming.



The camp is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged articles.

FOOD: Please do not pack food, gum, seeds or junk food. All food will be confiscated and not returned. DO NOT MAIL FOOD OR CANDY PARCELS. PARCELS WILL BE CONFISCATED AND NOT RETURNED.



**ALLERGIES**: *CAMP MASSAD IS NUT FREE*. Camp Massad takes precautions to avoid common allergens, for example, the removal

of peanut butter and all nut products from the campsite. Many foods have nuts *hidden* in the ingredients. This makes it imperative that we have your co-operation in **not sending** food of any kind to camp.

**PACKING:** Suggested packing lists are included to help you prepare. Please note that storage space in the cabins is very limited. Each camper is allowed a maximum of **two pieces of luggage and one carry-on backpack**. All clothing must be packed and sent with your child to camp. **It is not possible to drop items off at the campsite.** Please mark every article with your child's name.



**WATER**: Our water is safe to drink but water coolers are available with bottled drinking water. We ask that each camper bring a refillable water bottle.

**MAIL**: Campers look forward to receiving mail so please remember to send **postcards** and letters regularly to your child. Due to slow mail delivery to the beach we suggest you send something a few days prior to the session, to ensure your child receives mail early in the session.

Experience has demonstrated that our campers enjoy frequent letters, which may include a bit of family news, some jokes or riddles, and perhaps a plan for what the family may do upon the child's return. It is understandable that families and campers miss each other, which is why positive, happy letters are eagerly anticipated and really appreciated. Receiving letters

which outline many activities that the family did in their absence may make campers feel as if they are missing out on things while they are at camp. Please also remember that homesickness is normal and natural, and that often it occurs in the first few days of camp and after children receive letters from home. Staff members are well prepared to deal with these occurrences.

**PARENTS ON CAMPSITE:** We ask that parents not visit the campsite while camp is in session. While we hope that each camper can attend for his/her full session, if a child has to arrive late or leave early, arrangements must be made in advance with camp staff who will bring the camper to the Winnipeg Beach tennis courts to meet parents/guardians.

**VALUABLES**: Leave them at home! Camp Massad takes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal belongings. **NO** cell phones, ipads, laptops, etc. **AT ALL!** 

TELEPHONE: The camp telephone is for business and emergency use only. No child will be called to the phone. If there is a problem or concern, we will not hesitate to contact you. In the event of an emergency, the camp phone number is 1-204-389-5300. Please refrain from calling unless it's an emergency.

**PARENTS:** In order to facilitate a smooth transition for all campers, parents **MUST** send their children to camp by bus. Families in the **Interlake** area can arrange for the bus to pick-up/drop off their children in Winnipeg Beach, at the park adjacent to the tennis courts on the corner of Hazel and Prospect. Please notify the camp at least 24 hours in advance to make these arrangements. If you choose this option, please add an hour to your drop-off time and subtract an hour from your pick-up time.
